Keith Guttin



Beginning his 26th year of guiding the Missouri State baseball program, head coach Keith Guttin continues to build the Bears into one of the top programs, not just in the Missouri Valley Conference or Midwest but in NCAA Division I.

Under Guttin, the Bears are 864-536 (an average of 35 wins and 21 losses per season) and have won 62 percent of their games. Guttin has had seven 40-win

A part of the MSU baseball program as a player, assistant coach and head coach for

28 of the program's 42 years, Guttin took the helm of Bears baseball at the start of the 1983 season, coinciding with the move of Missouri State athletics to Division I status. He inherited the reins of the program from its only previous head baseball coach, current Missouri state discrete of stabletics Bill David State director of athlétics Bill Rowe.

Guttin stretched the string of MSU consecutive winning seasons to 32 in a row; easily the longest of any Missouri State athletics team. The Bears have finished in the top half of the conference race every year but two in the last 29 seasons.

Guttin directed Missouri State to six straight league titles in Mid-Continent play from 1984 through 1989. He gave MSU its first two Valley postseason tournament championships in 1996 and 1997. He was voted the MVC Coach of the Year in 1993, 2001 and 2003 and was selected the American Baseball Coaches Association Division I Midwest Region Coach of the Year in 1997 and again in 2003.

Paul Evans



Paul Evans moves into his 20th season with the Bears, having come to Missouri State as pitching coach in 1989 after three years as head coach at Rend Lake College. Evans also serves as the recruiting coordinator for the baseball Bears.

Over the past two seasons, Evans has coached the two highest draft picks in MSU history, with Brett Sinkbeil going 19th overall in 2006 and Ross Detwiler as the sixth overall pick in 2007. Detwiler made his major league debut with the Washington Nationals on Sept. 7, 2007, a mere 108 days after his final outing in a Bears' uniform.

In fact, Evans has coached three first round pitchers in the last seven seasons, including John Rheinecker as the 37th overall pick in 2001. A total of 41 hurlers have signed pro contracts under Evans' tutelage, with at least one in each of his 20 seasons and four advancing to the major leagues. Additionally, Evans has seen three Bears selected to pitch for Team USA: Jarrod Mays (1995), Bob Zimmerman (2001 and 2002) and Detwiler (2006).

Evans was head coach at Shawnee Junior College and assisted at RLC two years before becoming head coach. A Central Illinois Collegiate League and Cape Cod League hurler, he returned to Cape Cod in 1988 as pitching coach at Yarmouth-Dennis.
